Reward Being Offered in Relief Nursery Criminal Mischief Case Case No. 09-12995

A \$1,000 reward is being offered by a group of concerned citizens for information that leads to an arrest in the break-in, vandalism and reckless burning of a Relief Nursery RV that occurred last week.

Sometime between July 16, at 4:30 p.m. and July 17, at 5:45 a.m. the Relief Nursery's RV at 1720 West 25th was broken into. The RV, which was used as a food pantry had been entered and vandalized.

It appears the RV was entered via a vent on top of the vehicle. Once inside the suspect(s) emptied the contents of food throughout the RV including a can of chili that was thrown on the inside walls. Additionally, investigators found evidence of a small fire inside the RV.
